

Chorus Syllabus

Outline: This course will give you the opportunity to explore music vocally. You will be given a wide range of choir music, exercises, warm-ups, etc. to assist you in your growth as a musician. We will focus on the flexibility and dexterity of each voice as well as the individual who is performing.

Expectations: Each student is required to perform in at least two concerts per year, as well as other performances around the county. You are expected to come to class on time with all of the supplies needed for class. Tardiness will not be tolerated. You are expected to act in a respectful manner while in the classroom, and your behavior should reflect that of the student handbook.

Supplies:

- A 1 subject notebook, composition book, or loose leaf paper for the avid students and incoming freshman.
- Pencils, one for your music folder and one on hand.
- A folder for handouts.

Grading: Your grades will be largely based on class participation. Coming to class on time, and being in the class is crucial. You will also have several quizzes, playing tests, and reading and writing assignments. Your concerts will count as a grade as well.
