Florida Statewide Assessment (FSA) – Algebra 1

According to Florida law, students must meet all academic requirements in order to earn a standard high school diploma from a public school. The Florida Statewide Assessment (FSA) is a required assessment and will count 30% of the student's final Algebra grade.

Students entering 9th grade in 2015-2016, must pass the Algebra I FSA with a Level 3 or better and earn an Algebra credit by earning a passing grade in an Algebra class.

Tests

I will let you know in advance when a test is coming up. We will have 2 – 3 tests each quarter.

Quizzes

Most quizzes will be announced ahead of time, however, pop quizzes may be used occasionally to ensure that students are keeping up with their assignments and understanding the material.

Homework

Homework will be assigned on a regular basis. Students will have class notes with examples to use as a guideline for their homework. **All figures and work must be shown for full credit and must be written in pencil.** Late homework may be turned in before the chapter test. No homework will be accepted after the chapter test. If all homework assignments are completed, corrected, and turned in prior to taking the test, a 5 point bonus will be added to the chapter test grade. There is a 20% deduction for any work turned in after its due date.

Classwork/Bellringer

There will be days where you will have an assignment to complete in class. I will collect this work and count it as a grade. I will also check your Bellringer and assign a grade. We will have at least 10-12 classwork/Bellringer grades each quarter.
