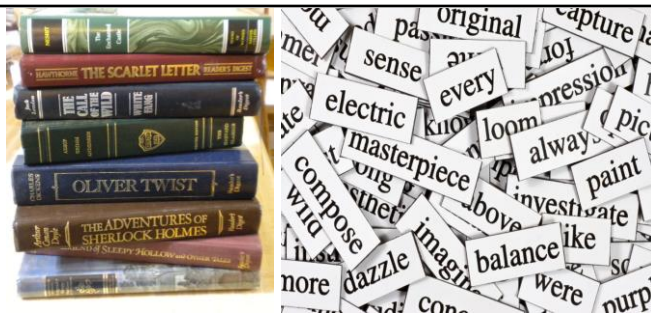
Course Overview
