Minutes

Taylor Locke (SFMHS SAC Chairperson) called the meeting to attendance at 6:00p and welcomed the SAC to the fifth meeting of the 2017-2018 school year.

Taylor Locke asked everyone to review the minutes from the February 5, 2018, meeting. Janet Hildebrand motioned to accept the minutes with no changes, and JoAnn Bova seconded the motion. None opposed.

Sarai Dutton (SFMHS Testing Coordinator) gave a second semester testing update and provided a testing schedule handout. A copy of the handout Sarai provided is included with the meeting documentation.

Sarai Dutton (SFMHS Parent Involvement Coordinator) also provided information on our upcoming ESOL night on March 6<sup>th</sup> and Wolfpack 2020/Tutoring. A copy of the handout Sarai provided is included with the meeting documentation.

Joan Downen (SFMHS DAC Representative) gave a DAC report. DAC has become more interactive and less sit-and-get. The next meeting on March 14<sup>th</sup> will feature Dr. Greg Adkins and his vision for the 2018-2019 school year.

Ed Mathews gave his principal's report on the ABCs of SFMHS.

- Attendance: SFMHS was 4<sup>th</sup> highest in high school attendance right behind FMHS, NFHS, and DHS.



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- Behavior: February 2018 had 60 less discipline referrals than February 2017 and 200 less discipline referrals than February 2016.
- Curriculum: Wolfpack 2020 is afterschool tutoring and direct instruction. Cyber Security is starting certification. Anyone with a level 1 welding certification will be hired by BNI for \$22 an hour right out of high school. HOSA has their state competition the first weekend of April, and they are expected to do well. FPLA has had great success for their first of year of being an organization. A Head Pinz trip based off of STAR ELA/Math and US History results is being planned for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter.
- We've been challenging seniors to fill out FASFA. So far, 200+ applications have been filled out, which is the 4<sup>th</sup> highest amount for the county. We have been giving out class rings for participation.
- All seniors filled out a free application for FSW this past fall to encourage a higher education track.
- Due to the events in Parkland, SFMHS has been working with students and teachers to bring kindness in school and to bring everyone together.
- Janet Hildebrand asked Ed Mathews how he felt about arming teachers, and he said he will follow the law.

Joan Downen gave a technology training on the FOCUS Parent Portal. She showed how to access attendance, calendar, and grades.

For the good of the order, Janet asked if we were going to discuss SAC grants this year, and Taylor Locke responded there was not money for SAC grants this year.

Allison Demming made a motion to adjourn the meeting, and Janet Hildebrand seconded the motion. None opposed. Taylor Locke announced that the next SAC Meeting was May 7th, at 6p and adjourned the meeting at 6:42p.



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
