

The 2-D Design course is designed to address two-dimensional (2-D) design issues. Design involves purposeful decision making about how to use the Elements of Art and Principles of Design in an integrative way. Through practical experience students will develop mastery in the concept, composition, and execution of their ideas.

The 2-D Design student will explore creative thinking and problem solving for design projects. Students will learn how to seek out creative solutions that are interesting and challenging.

Works to be considered may include drawing, painting, printmaking, collage, montage, and photography.

Student Expectations

- Please be punctual and ready for instruction when the bell rings.
- Be respectful to all.
- Treat materials in the studio with respect. Students are expected to clean up their work area, clean supplies and return them to their proper places.
- Each day a new "Bell Ringer" will be posted. This is to be completed while I take attendance. Bell work will be checked each week.
- Assignments should be done to the best of your ability. Late assignments will not receive full credit unless prior arrangements have been made with me. If you are absent, it is your responsibility to find out what you missed and make it up.

Homework is not generally assigned. Since most work will be done in class, regular attendance is vital.

Class Participation

You are expected to use your time in class focused on making art. Time is divided between drawing (thumbnail sketches/designing), writing exercises and full projects.

Grading

Art grades are based on effort, responsibility, following directions, quality, craftsmanship, creativity, and meeting the standards and benchmarks stated in each rubric for each assignment.

Required Materials

You are expected to bring a pencil and eraser to class each day. A 3-prong/2 pocket folder is needed to maintain Bell work, handouts and written work. All other materials needed for class will be provided. Please have a black Sharpie.

Students are asked to submit **\$10** to the art department to help provide appropriate supplies and materials to supplement those provided by the school. These supplies will enhance the student's artistic development.

Extra credit is given for paper towels, box of tissues, and/or 20# white copier paper.
