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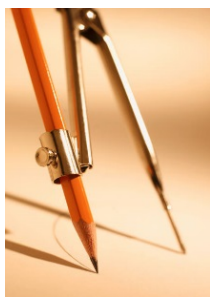

*The End of Course (EOC) Geometry Exam will be taken at the end of the year as scheduled by the state. This exam will count as 20-30% of the overall course grade.

Tests:

When appropriate, students will be allowed to use a scientific calculator on some tests. There will be a test after every chapter. Students are responsible for making up any tests missed due to a class absence. A grade of zero will be recorded for any tests not made-up. Tests will be made up the next class after the absence and by teacher arrangement. Projects may be assigned periodically and will count as a test grade.

Quizzes:

Quizzes will be used to ensure that students are keeping up with their assignments, understanding the material, and using their notes as a means of daily review. Make-up procedures will be the same as for tests.

Classwork/ Homework:

Classwork and Homework will be assigned on a regular basis. Students should use class notes containing examples as a guideline for any homework assigned. All figures and work must be shown for full credit. All assignments must be done in pencil. **LATE WORK WILL BE REDUCED BY HALF FOR EACH DAY LATE.**

Attendance:

It is the responsibility of the student to make up any work missed due to an **excused absence**. Students will be allowed the number of days absent plus one to complete all make-up work.

Textbook:

A textbook will be issued to each student. Each student is responsible for his or her own textbook. On-line access to the textbook will be discussed in class during the first few weeks of school. All supplies and textbook materials must be brought to class every day.
