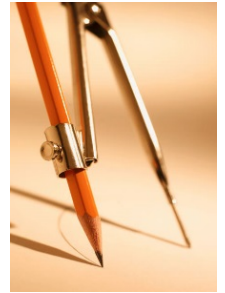

**Note:** Calculator apps on cellphones or any electronic devices will not be permitted.

\*The End of Course (EOC) Geometry Exam will be taken at the end of the year as scheduled by the state. This exam will count as 20-30% of the overall course grade.

## *What's My Grade?*

## Tests:

There will be a test given about every 2-3 weeks. Students will be allowed to use an EOC reference sheet and a scientific calculator on all tests. Students are responsible for making up any tests missed due to a class absence. **An automatic grade of 30% will be recorded for any tests not made-up within one week of the absence** or by teacher arrangement. It is imperative that students attend every class, especially on test days. Moreover, students will also have a Midterm Exam, a Final Exam and the Geometry End of Course Exam. Projects may be assigned and will count as a test grade.

## Quizzes:

Quizzes will be used to ensure that students are keeping up with their assignments, understanding the material, and using their notes as a means of daily review. Students will be allowed to use an EOC reference sheet and a calculator on all quizzes. Students are responsible for making up any quizzes missed due to a class absence. **An automatic grade of 0% will be recorded for any quizzes not made-up within one week of the absence.**

## Classwork/Homework:

Classwork and Homework will be assigned on a regular basis. Students should use class notes containing examples as a guideline for any homework assigned. All figures and work must be shown for full credit. At the end of each quarter the lowest Homework grade will be dropped; however, any **late work** will be reduced by half for each day late.

## Attendance:

Students should attend school every day. It is the responsibility of the student to make up any work missed due to an **excused absence**. Students will be allowed the number of days absent plus one to complete all make-up work.

## Textbook:

A textbook will be issued to each student. Each student is responsible for his or her own textbook. Students should use the textbook at home for further learning by reading each chapter and reviewing for tests.

## Notebook:

In order to keep students organized and make sure that they have their notes accessible all year long, students will turn in their binders for a notebook check. Notebook checks will be conducted at the teacher's discretion and unannounced, at least once per quarter. This grade will count as **two Quiz grades**. Binders must have this syllabus in front of **all** of their class notes (in order by chapter).
