

Edgenuity Course Syllabus

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Course Objective:

To provide students with the opportunity to retake courses or recover credits for the purpose of meeting graduation requirements.

Computer Lab Rules:

- Enter/leave classroom quietly
- Remain at your assigned station unless directed to move by the teacher
- Conceal all electronic devices in backpacks/purses and place them on the floor
- Keep your work area neat and clean; notify the teacher immediately if equipment is missing or inoperative
- Work independently
- Use the Edgenuity program while in the computer lab

Students are expected to follow all Computer Lab rules and use their time to complete all of their coursework on time. In addition, all school-wide rules are expected to be followed and students must complete all tasks with their best effort and conduct. Not following Computer Lab and school rules will result in disciplinary action.

Assignments

Students will be enrolled in, and complete coursework using Edgenuity. You must complete a course in the same semester in which you enrolled. You are responsible for checking your Progress Report daily and staying current in the course you are taking. You may take more than one course during a semester, but they must be taken one course at a time. If you are not making satisfactory progress, you may be withdrawn from the course.

Grades/Grade Weights:

Passing scores for all assessments are 70%

STUDENTS DO NOT RECEIVE GRADES IN THE PINNACLE GRADING SYSTEM. Grades are submitted at the end of the semester. Progress reports can be e-mailed to you weekly, or you can request a paper copy be sent home. Please be sure your e-mail address is current. Progress reports will be sent home weekly by the program. If you need a paper copy, please let your teacher know and it can be printed.

ATTENDANCE IS CRITICAL to the success of the program, as students can only log in to the program from school. Repeated absences are grounds for removal from consideration for future placement.
