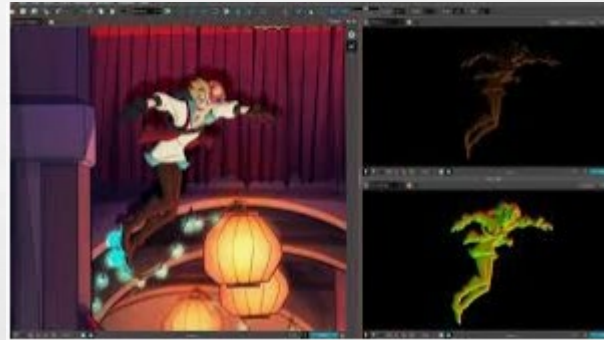

- **IF A CLASS IS 1 CREDIT, YOU WILL ENTER THE NAME OF THE CLASS IN BOTH SEMESTER 1 & SEMESTER 2 IN THE GOOGLE FORM.**
