



What is the Cambridge (AICE) Program?

- The Cambridge Program was developed as a pre-university program by the University of Cambridge.
- The exams associated with the program have been offered for over 50 years and are given in more than 160 countries and 10,000 schools.
- The courses are based on critical thinking skills rather than memorization.
- Students are expected to look at issues and topics with a global perspective.
- Assessments are written exams which require independent, critical analysis and clear concise communication skills.

How can you earn the **AICE** Diploma?





Total of 7 credits required for diploma



Cambridge International AS Level = one credit



Cambridge International A Level = two credits

Learners can accumulate credit for the diploma over a 25-month period.

How do I apply for the AICE Diploma?



On the paperwork you picked up tonight

- 1. Complete the interest form and turn it in on your way out last 2 pages of your packet.

 This will get the process started but it is not complete until the application is submitted.
- 2. You will find this QR code on the 2nd page of the paperwork scan the code and complete the form.



3. Use one of computers in the lobby to submit the application tonight.

What happens next?

- Once your application has been <u>evaluated a letter</u> will be sent to you and your student no later than <u>February 15th</u>.
- If your student is accepted, YOU MUST Complete and return your commitment letter by <u>February 22nd</u> to <u>secure</u> your seat for the AICE program at SFMHS. <u>If you do not return commitment letter</u>
 <u>by the requested date you will LOSE YOUR SPOT.</u>
- In April/May you will receive and invitation to attend AICE Open House where we will host a meet and greet with your fellow AICE students, register you for classes, give you a chance to meet your AICE teachers

What will we do to support your student after they are accepted into the AICE Program?

- Quarterly meetings with Mrs.
 Grodzki to identify areas of success and areas for improvement.
- Bi-annual meetings with assigned guidance counselor for future planning regarding AICE pathway, graduation requirements, volunteer opportunities and long term college and career goals.
- Alignment with a Freshman success or AVID class to support students in their first year of high school and to maximize their success.
